## AT THE THEATER

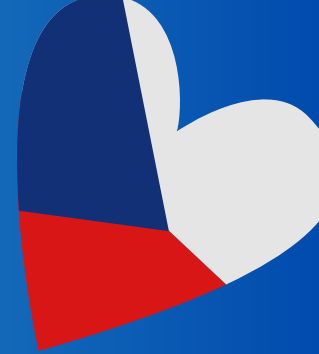

I just want to stay and play

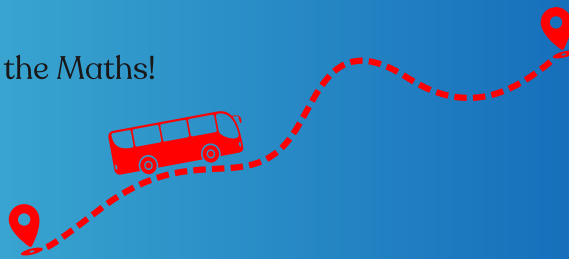
## CHORUS
